Council has appointed local construction company Civil Plus Constructions to complete the following important works:

Ross Dam to Douglas Water Treatment Plant Pipeline Duplication

Council is duplicating the Ross River Dam to Douglas Water Treatment Plant (RRD to DWTP) pipeline, a key water infrastructure asset essential to Townsville's water supply which provides up to 85% of the city's water.

Works will duplicate the existing pipeline. Installing a duplicate pipeline will further enhance Townsville's water security. The duplicate pipeline will cross Ross River near the dam, run parallel to the river through the Mount Stuart Training Area before connecting to the Douglas Water Treatment Plant.

UPDATE/NEW INFORMATION: CHANGE OF WORKHOURS ADVICE

From Saturday 29 October, Council has amended and approved work hours on Monday to Friday 6am to 6pm and Saturday 6am to 5pm.

The extension of contractor work hours is to facilitate completion of concreting and pipe laying work across the Ross River ahead of the approaching wet season.

Concreting pours will commence this weekend 29 October (weather permitting).

Local amenity impacts may involve noise, warning lights, vehicle operating alarms, vibration and occasional dust.
