

COVID-19 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Any persons entering these premises agrees to comply with the following “Conditions of Entry”, which have been implemented in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic for the purpose of keeping patrons and staff safe. These safety measures in place are intended to minimise the risk of contracting the COVID-19 virus, but this risk cannot be completely eliminated. Visitors enter this site at their own risk.

We need to know:

- In the last 14 days have you travelled from overseas or a COVID-19 hotspot?
- Have you been in close contact with a person who is positive for COVID-19?
- Are you an active COVID-19 case?
- Are you currently, or have you recently experienced cough, fever, sore throat, fatigue or shortness of breath?
- Are you awaiting COVID-19 test results?

All patrons entering this site:

- Must provide their name and contact details and consent to Townsville City Council providing these details to the QLD Department of Health or any other third-party government department, as required to enable contact tracing procedures.
- Adhere to all signage and staff advice in relation to queuing, movement through the site and entry and exit points to ensure social distancing of 1.5m is always maintained .
- Comply with all reasonable directions from staff.
- Treat staff and other visitors with respect.
- Patrons can be refused entry or requested to leave this site at any time if they display signs of illness or fail to follow the terms and conditions outlined above.
